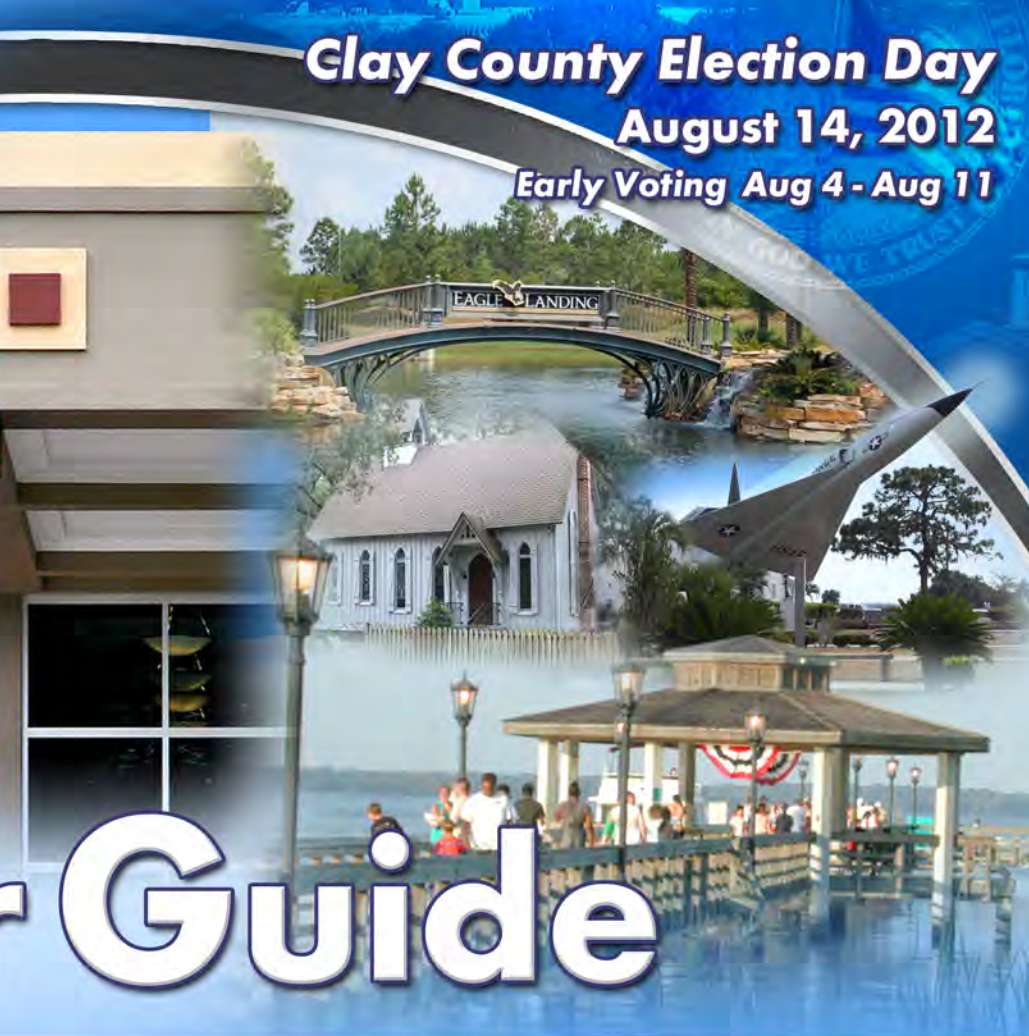

Gambling has expanded in Clay County through "INTERNET CAF� SWEEPSTAKES" slot machine locations. Patrons gamble on computers programmed as slot machines after buying a chance in a sweepstake game along with a product or service. Concerning these "Internet Caf� Sweepstakes" slot machine locations in Clay County (aka Adult Arcade Amusement Centers), number from 1 to 3 the following in the order of your preference.
A Ban permanently all locations/centers.
B Allow no further expansion of these locations/centers, maintaining stringent regulations on those remaining.
C Keep the stringent regulations of the current ordinances 2012-2 and 2012-3.
D Make the regulations for the locations/centers <u>more</u> stringent than the current ordinances.
E Make the regulations for the locations/centers <u>less</u> stringent than the current ordinances.
F Place no restrictions on these locations/centers.
